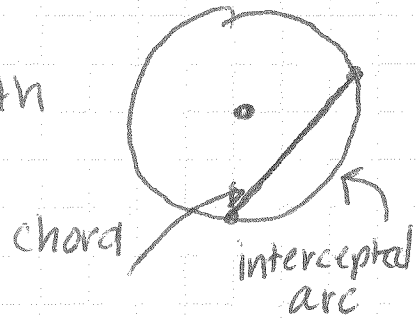


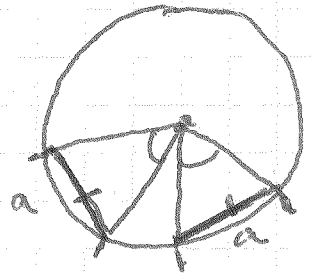
6.2 Chords

* A chord is a line segment with endpoints on a circle



* An intercepted arc is the arc with endpoints on the chord's endpoints

* If two chords are congruent, then their central angles will also be congruent.



* If two chords are congruent, then their intercepted arcs will be congruent.

* The perpendicular bisector of a chord passes through the center, and vice versa
